104/24 Chairmans Annual Report:

The Chairman presented his annual report to the meeting, highlighting the work undertaken by the Council during the year.

The Council had provided grants to the Craven Arms Youth Club, Craven Arms Discovery Centre, Craven Arms Events Committee and Cave23.

Discissions had taken place with Highways England and Shropshire Council relating to highway issues however issues remain particularly with the road surface of Corvedale Road Craven Arms. The trees along Brook Road adjoining the Railway had been a concern for some time however Network Rail had agreed to become responsible their maintenance which removed the responsibility from the Town

The Flood group had been reformed, and it is hoped that future progress will be made on a future Craven Arms Flood Relief Scheme.

The Chairman thanked the Clerk and fellow councillors for their work undertaken during the year.

105/24 Financial Report:

The Clerk presented the financial report for the year 2024/25 which showed balances of £207,556 at the 31st March 2025 and details of the Councils Income and Expenditure for the Year.
